Homework Policy

Homework provides the opportunity for pupils to revisit, review and extend prior learning. Homework can also provide an entry point to a new topic.

Daily (Minimum)

Pupils should practise:

- Number bonds (Year 1/2)
- Times Tables (refer to **curriculum** for which tables the year group need to learn)
- All pupils to read at home

Weekly (Minimum)

Reading books to be changed and sent home:

- Nursery once and increase frequency in-line with developing an interest in books and early skills
- Reception once in Autumn 1 and as pupils become more competent increase in-line with their needs
- KS1 once and increase in-line with pupil competence
- KS2 books will be changed in line with pupil competence and the type of text they
 are reading
- Home school reading logs to be read and initialled (ALL)
- Word pockets (<u>High Frequency Words</u>) should be sent home with pupils and words should be tested weekly (**Year R Y2**)
- Pupils should first focus on reading and then spelling words
- Parent to be given the whole list of words to be learnt.

Spelling

- The Letters & Sounds Phonic Programme should be used to select progressive spelling homework (Year 1)
- The **Support for Spelling Programme** should be used to select progressive spelling homework (**Year 2-6**)
- By Year 2 pupils should be able to spell the first 200 HFWs words

Half-termly

- Topic homework to be sent home during the topic
- All returned topic work is to be marked on return
