Homework Questions for Y4: Spring 2

Week 1	Light and Sound
WB 6.3.23	Investigate how light and sound travels. Do they travel in a straight line? Do they bounce off objects? Create a cartoon strip with as much information as you can about light and sound. Remember to include as many scientific keywords as possible!
Week 2	Sutton Hoo: An important discovery from Anglo-Saxon times
WB 13.3.23	What is Sutton Hoo? Why is it a well-known and a significant place? Create a poster showing information on the importance of Sutton Hoo. Check some of the resources from the British Museum here: https://www.britishmuseum.org/learn/schools/ages-7-11/ancient-britain/classroom-resource-sutton-hoo
Week 3	Transportation
WB 20.3.23	How do you and your family travel? Research into different modes of transport that you, friends or family members use. Think about how you will present your information (diagram, graph, pie chart, bar chart, etc.)
Week 4	William Morris
WB 27.3.23	Research the works of artist William Morris. Why is he famous? What did he use as inspiration for his work? Experiment with different patterns to create a work of art in the style of William Morris.
