# **SCIENCE:**

In Science this half term children will be learning about living things and their offspring, adaptation and how the human body works and functions. They will explore different offspring, comparing different types of adaptation and how this may lead to evolution and investigate humans and how they grow and age.

# **DESIGN TECHNOLOGY**

In DT, we will be learning about textiles, specifically embroidery.

They will be understanding the different types of stitching and the process in making items of clothing. They will develop their own ideas in order to make their own embroided T-shirt.

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# **HISTORY**

In History, we will continuing to be learning all about WW2. We will have an understanding the impact of the war on everyday life in Britain and be able to plot the allied and axis territories on a map.

# **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

In RE, we are going to be learning about Christianity.

We will be understanding all about eternity and we will be looking at the key question: Is anything ever eternal?

# **GEOGRAPHY**

In Geography this half term, we are continuing to study all about South America. We will look at understanding where South America is located on a map, marking the countries and lakes, understanding the population, mountains and rivers of South America and understanding their importance.

# ART AND DESIGN

In art we will be continuing to learn all about the Mayans in the form of drawing. We will also be beginning to look at the unit of: Sculpture and 3D, where we will be exploring different sculptural techniques.

In PSHE we will be following the Jigsaw program and will be focusing on 'Dreams and Goals.' In this unit, children will explore the following:
