READING

Week 3

History: Can you create a timeline of your life up until Year 1?

Art: Can you create a colour wheel?



There are so many different colours. Mix different colours together to see how many colours you can make. You can use paints, colouring pens, pencils, whatever you want!

Geography: Can you create a map of your local area?



In geography we will be learning about the UK and the countries within the UK. Do you know which country we live in? Do you know which area we live in? Which area is Woodside in?
