Safety is paramount – it will be at the discretion of the Headship team if pupils will be required to return to Home Learning if a child is deemed unsafe.

### **School**

#### **The school will do its best to:**

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection and REAch2 risk assessments;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' test positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, social media, email and the school website.

#### **To help my child at school, I know and understand that:**

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately. I will either get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone or my child will self-isolate for the required period;
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules;
- Only one adult will drop off and collect my child each day to limit number of people around the school site;
- If my child has permission to walk home alone (Year 6 only), I have spoken to them about the 2 metre social distancing rules, and am confident that they can follow them;
- If my child walks to school alone (Year 6 only), they will not arrive more than 5 minutes earlier than their start time;
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly follow the school timings for my child and will ensure that they are not late

- When dropping off, my child will remove any disposable face mask they are wearing, placing disposable ones in the bin/double bag or in the case of a fabric one, I will take it away with me;
- My child will not bring any items into school with them (exceptions include coats, lunchbox, water bottles, personal hygiene items and hats in the case of hot weather) or take items home from school. A PE kit is not needed;
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an ‘as safe as possible’ environment during this time;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I will inform the school of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details;
- I will follow social distancing rules at all times, and understand if there is evidence that I have not followed social distancing, my child may have to return to home learning;
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will return to home learning and cannot return to school until they can be safe;
- If my child has a mobile phone with them (Year 6 only) they will keep it in their toolkit/bag within the classroom. Mobiles will be turned off at all times. The school accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage whilst the device is on school premises;
- I will provide my child with a filled water bottle on a daily basis which will be taken home each day to be washed;
- I will make sure that my child is wearing a washed set of clothes every day. The wearing of school uniform is optional but a washed set must be worn daily.

**To help me at school, I know and understand that I need to:**

- Follow the Bubble rules that keep me safe;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Not bring any items into school with me (exceptions include coats, lunchbox, water bottles, personal hygiene items and hats in the case of hot weather) or take items home from school. A PE kit is not needed;
- Only use the equipment in my pack or on my table;
- Not mix with any other children in the school;
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate;
- Follow the catch it-bin it-kill it rules coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue;
- Regularly wash my hands using soap and water for 20 seconds, including when I enter the school;
- Follow the 2 metre social distancing rules if I have permission to walk home alone (Year 6 only);
- Keep my mobile phone (Year 6 only) in my bag during school hours. If I do not follow this rule I will be asked to keep my phone at home whilst at school;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will return to learning at home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
