Sports Club Policy

Aims and Purposes

Physical Education and sport is a vital and unique part of every child's education. It develops children's knowledge, skills and understanding so that they can perform with increasing competence and confidence in a range of physical activities. It promotes an understanding in children of their bodies in action. It involves thinking, selecting and applying skills and promotes positive attitudes towards a healthy lifestyle thus enabling them to make informed choices about physical activity throughout their lives.

Our sports clubs are run before school, during lunchtime and after school to enhance the PE offered in the curriculum. Children attending our sports clubs are able to further develop their PE skills, improve their fitness levels, experience competition and start to foster links with sports clubs in the community.

Procedures

Parents of pupils attending sports clubs will need to sign and return the Sports Club Policy Permission Agreement below.

Children attending before school clubs must be dropped off on time and those attending after school clubs must be picked up on time.

- For the Forest site this is 7:45am before school and 4:30pm after school.
- For the Bridge site this is 8am before school and 4:45pm after school.

If a child is picked up late they will miss the following week's session. If this happens again the child will have their place taken and they will no longer be permitted to attend the club.

Pupils

Pupils attending sports club will need to abide by the following rules:

- Follow the school's behaviour policy, failure to do so will result in a ban from the club. The gravity of the incident will determine the length of the ban. For a serious breach of policy, such as fighting, this would result in an indefinite ban.
- Follow the school's life values of determination, independence, confidence, kindness, honesty, respect and responsibility.
- Wear the school PE kit (black shorts/joggers, white t-shirt and black plimsolls/trainers) and remove all jewellery. Children will not be permitted to take part in the session without appropriate clothing.
