Homework Questions for Y2: Autumn Term 2 2020

Topic – Light Up The Night

Week 1	How do we keep safe around fire?
Notes	<p>When used correctly, fire can be very useful. However, when it is used without care, it can cause an accident.</p> <p>This week, create a poster that details how to be safe around fire. You can make your poster as exciting and colourful as you want. Try to use the following words/numbers in your poster: matches, fireplace, candles, fire engine, 999, smoke, safe and adult.</p>
Week 2	Who keeps us safe from fire?
Notes	<p>There are many people who keep us safe. The fire brigade keep us safe from fires. A fire engine is a very important piece of equipment as it has many different parts that have been specially designed.</p> <p>For your homework, compare fire engines from the past to those of the present. Draw and label the different functions and special parts of each fire engine.</p>
Week 3	The history of the fire brigade
Notes	<p>The London Fire Brigade was formed in 1865. Over time they have changed to help fight fires better.</p> <p>Using a range of resources, create a 3D model of a modern fire engine. Remember to include all the parts you labelled in last week's homework.</p>
Week 4	Explorers, what can you see?
Notes	<p>Our Topic for next term will be <i>Land Ahoy!</i> During this topic we will be learning about pirates and explorers. Our classrooms will be decorated to match our topic so we would like you to make something to put in your classroom after Christmas.</p> <p>Ideas- You could make a pirate flag, a model pirate ship, a treasure chest, a parrot, a map, some binoculars or a telescope, or anything else that could be used by pirates or explorers!</p> <p>We look forward to using your marvellous creations to decorate our classrooms ready for January!</p>
