




# Year 6 Overview

Autumn term 2 is "It's all Greek to me!"

## SCIENCE



Our science topic this term will be a focus on **Sound** - pupils will have the opportunity to investigate sound and experiment with how sound is made. They will also investigate, explain and demonstrate the pattern between the volume of a sound and the distance from its source  
Through different investigations they will present their information in a variety of different ways.

## GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, we will be: using Maps, researching and analysing maps identifying grid references and applying knowledge of maps. The children will have the opportunity to identify and describe how the physical features affect the human activity within a location (linking to farming, land use and tourism) and also have time to give views on the effectiveness of different geographical representations of a location (such as aerial images compared with maps and topological maps - as in London's Tube map).



We will also be looking at how to keep ourselves safe and as a whole school, take part in Anti-Bullying Week. We will also review the 7 life values within these lessons and how we have continued to reconnect into the school environment after lockdown and discuss how we feel now that we are into the second National lockdown.

## PE

This term, we will continue developing our ball skills of catching, passing, throwing and bouncing through a variety team games in our bubbles.



## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE, we will be looking at Christianity and discussing two Key Questions

- 1) How significant is it that Mary was Jesus' mother?
- 2) Do Christmas celebrations and traditions help Christians understand who Jesus was and why he was born?

## D.T

In D.T., we will explore the origins of the Advent calendar and have the opportunity to design, make and evaluate a fabric advent calendar. The children will develop, model and communicate ideas through talking, drawing, templates, mock-ups and prototypes and evaluate the finished product.



## MUSIC

In music, the children will continue to explore different rhythmic patterns and structure from the Ancient worlds with a focus on syncopation and analysing complex rhythms.
