Homework Questions for Year 2: Autumn 1

Notes	History
Week 1 w/ b 19th September 2022	Who was Samuel Pepys? Find out about Samuel Pepys. Where did he live? What was he famous for? What interesting facts can you find out about him?
Week 2 w/b 26 th September 2022	How did the fire spread? Find out where and when the fire started and how it spread across London. Why did it spread so quickly? Which parts of London did the fire affect? What did people do during the fire? How did people put the fire out? How long did it burn for?
Notes	Art
Week 3 w/b 3 rd October 2022	Weather Art Create a piece of art based on the weather using different mediums (e.g. colouring pencils, felt tips, natural resources etc). Think about the colours that you use and what they represent. Are you going to use warm colours to represent heat and the sun or are you going to use cool colours to represent cold? Get inspiration from famous artists who have created art pieces based on the weather.
